Versant Power Comments

On February 3, 2023, the Maine Public Utilities Commission (Commission) issued a procedural order requesting additional information from Central Maine Power and Versant Power (Company) regarding how the two utilities calculated the number of Level 2 projects. Versant Power reproduces the question and respectfully submits its response below.

Question

Q: For each utility, please provide the back-up data to support the analysis performed to calculate the number of level 2 projects included in the joint response.

- A. Versant Power received 77 Level 2 applications, all of which were cancelled or withdrawn. Thirty-four of these Level 2 projects reapplied as Level 4.
