SCHEDULE OF RATES

Rates for water listed below are available in the area served by the West Paris Water District.

FIXTURE RATES

No water will be supplied under fixture rates at a price less than that quoted below for the first faucet and one fixture of any installation shall be rated as "First Faucet". Both hot and cold water faucets emptying into the same vessel shall be counted as a single faucet.

SEASONAL METER RATES

The annual or seasonal Minimum Charge shall be: \$ 444.69

Availability:

This rate is available to all seasonal customers using water services less than twelve months of the year, including customers who use water from the District on an intermittent basis to supplement their own source of water supply or for purpose of irrigation.

When water is taken by a hose from a faucet other than a sillcock, the sillcock rate shall apply.

Terms of payment:

Bills under this rate are net and will be due and payable upon presentation. The District will bill the minimum charge when the water is first turned on, or else by May 1 of each year. If the minimum charge is exceeded, the excess will be billed monthly, quarterly, or at the end of the season at the option of the District.

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PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION RATE

For each private fire hydrant taking water from the public water system the charge will be:

For each sprinkler connection taking water from the public water system the charge will be:

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TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills under Fixture Rate and Private Fire Protection are net and will be rendered in advance. Whether billing is Quarterly, Semi-annual, or Seasonal shall be determined by the District.

INTEREST ON UNPAID BILLS

A charge of 1% per month will be assessed after 30 days from the billing date on all unpaid water bills.

METER RATES

Availability: This rate is available to all domestic, commercial, industrial and governmental water customers in the District except municipal and private fire protection.

Minimum Charge: For the customer served through a single meter, there will be a minimum charge, based on the size of the meter installed.

Terms of payment:

Bills under this rate are net and will be due and payable upon presentation. Whether the billing is monthly or quarterly, will be at the option of the utility.

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SERVICE FOR TOWN PURPOSE

HYDRANT AND TOWN RATES APPLICABLE TO THE TOWN OF WEST PARIS

- I. For the 42 fire hydrants on the system, all owned by the District and in existence on January 1, 2019, there shall be paid to the District by the Town of WEST PARIS, as fire protection charge, the sum of \$ 10,431.50 Quarterly.

- II. For each additional fire hydrant connected to any main in existence on January 1, 2019 or any additional fire hydrant authorized in writing by the Town an drequireing the installation of a new main 6" or larger in diameter there shall be paid to the District by the Town of WEST PARIS additional charges as computed under Chapter 69 of the Commission rules.

- III. All hydrants now in existence or to be installed will be cared for and maintained in good working order (unavoidable accidents excepted) by the District. Hydrants are to be connected only to mains having a diameter of 6" or larger. Once any fire hydrants are actually installed and in operation, the total monthly fire protection charge then in effect, shall not be reduced should the Town order one or more hydrants discontinued.

Should the Town order any hyudrant removed to a different location, the Town shall pay all costs of moving said hydrant or hydrants.

- IV. All present and future buildings or water service owned or operated by the Town, or owned and operated by any present or future school, sewer or other district or any subdivision thereof, shall be metered the same and shall be billed the regular filed meter rates. Further, the regular "Private Fire Protection" rates, if applicable, shall apply also to the above mentioned property. The Town shall be bound by all the applicable rules and regulations as filed with this rate schedule.

TERM OF PAYMENT:

Bills under this rate will be in advance and are due and payable upon presentation.

Whether the billing is monthly, quarterly, or semi-quarterly, is as agreed between the District and the Town.

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
