Consumption Charge

For the First 1,200 Cubic Feet or less	\$82.71
For the Next 7,200 Cubic Feet per quarter	\$6.24 per 100 cu. ft.
For the Next 81,600 Cubic Feet per quarter	\$3.11 per 100 cu. ft.
In excess of 90,000 Cubic Feet per quarter	\$2.33 per 100 cu. ft.

If billed monthly, consumption steps will be one-third of the quarterly charges.

Service Charge

The service charge for different meter sizes will be billed on either the monthly or quarterly basis in accordance with LFWD's billing procedures. LFWD may bill a quarterly customer on a monthly basis using one third the quarterly service charge.

protection service charge then in effect will not be reduced should the municipality
served order one or more hydrants discontinued.

Should the municipality order any hydrant or hydrants moved to a different location,
the municipality shall pay to the District all costs of removing and
and re-installing said hydrant or hydrants.

WHOLESALE SERVICES

AVAILABLE:

This schedule is available to Jay Village Water District ("JVWD") for resale to their customers.

RATES:

THE RATES FOR JVWD SHALL BE:

\$2.38 Per 100 cubic Feet

TERMS OF SERVICE AND PAYMENT:

The quantity of water purchased by JVWD shall be the total amount recorded at the point of interconnection and at the meter located at 133 Hyde Road, except in the case of inaccurate or missing flow data. Livermore Falls Water District ("LFWD") will bill JVWD monthly for consumption by JVWD in the preceding month. Bills issued by LFWD will clearly indicate the amount of water recorded for the billing period and the applicable rate charged by LFWD per unit measured. Payment must be received by LFWD by the date listed on the bill or within twenty-five (25) days of JVWD's receipt of the bill, whichever is later. In the event JVWD fails to make payment within the later of the due date listed on the bill or twenty-five (25) days of their receipt of the bill from LFWD, LFWD may charge a late payment charge pursuant to Chapter 870 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
