**QUARTERLY AND MONTHLY RATES FOR WATER
TO METERED CUSTOMERS**

Quarterly:

For the first	1,200 Cu. Ft. or less	\$	61.86	
Next	10,800 Cu. Ft. per quarter	\$	3.48	per 100 cubic feet
For all in excess of	12,000 Cu. Ft. per quarter	\$	1.93	per 100 cubic feet


If billed monthly, consumption steps and the Minimum Charge will be one-third of the quarterly charges.

MINIMUM CHARGES

For each customer served through a single meter, there shall be a Minimum Charge, based on the size of the meter installed:

PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION

Available:

For the public hydrants owned and maintained by the Water District and connected to the District's mains on July 1, 2022, there shall be paid to the District the following public fire protection service charge:

Town of Paris

\$214,804 Annually


\$53,701 Quarterly

Rate for hydrants installed after July 1, 2022, shall be determined in accordance with the Public Utilities Commission Rules and Regulations Chapter 69.

All public fire hydrants now existing or to be installed will be cared for and maintained in good working order (unavoidable accidents excepted) by the District. No hydrant will be installed on mains less than 6" in diameter. Once any fire hydrant is actually installed and in operation, the total annual fire protection service charge then in effect will not be reduced should the municipality served order one or more hydrants discontinued.

Should the municipality served order any hydrant or hydrants moved to a different location, the municipality served shall pay to the District all costs of moving said hydrant or hydrants.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION RATES

Available:

To customers using the District's service for private fire protection. The following rates apply to fire protection only and include no allowance of water or other than fire fighting purposes.

Rates:


Each private hydrant furnished, installed and maintained by the user for private fire protection, per year:

\$865.46 Annual Rate \$ 216.38 Quarterly Rate

Private fire service rate for automatic sprinklers, standpipes, or hose connections to be used only for fire protection inside of buildings, a charge per inch of service pipe diameter,
