RATE:

For the 33 Public fire hydrants owned and maintained by the Water District and connected to the District's mains as of January 1, 2019, there shall be paid to the District the following public fire service charge:

Town of Jay \$ 132,469 per year

33,118 per quarter, to be billed four times annually

For each public fire hydrant owned and maintained by the District and installed after January 1, 2019, charges will be governed by Chapter 690 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

All public hydrants now existing or to be installed will be maintained in good working order (unavoidable accidents excepted) by the Water District. Once any fire hydrant is actually installed and in operation, the total annual fire protection service charge then in effect will not be reduced, even though the municipality served should order one or more of its hydrants removed.

Should the municipality order the District to move any hydrant(s) to a different location, then the municipality shall pay the District all costs of removing and re-installation of the specific hydrant or hydrants.
