Rates for water listed below are applicable in the area served by the Andover Water District.

FIXTURE RATES

No water will be supplied under fixture rates at a price less than that quoted below for the "First Faucet". Both hot and cold water faucets emptying into the same fixture or vessel shall be counted as a single faucet

Existing or new customers may be permitted to continue on fixture rates at the option of the Trustees of the District until such time as meters may be installed.

For each family occupying separate dwellings or apartments or using -
fixtures, the charges shall be:



All classes of consumers, except for those for which service is specified in proceeding schedules, will be supplied with water only on a metered basis. Each meter will be billed separately and be subject to the regular minimum charges specified for the size of the meter.

Over 1,200 cubic feet per quarter	4.28 per 100 cubic feet


MINIMUM CHARGES

Availability

To the Town of Andover for municipal fire protection

RATE

For the 24 public fire hydrants owned and maintained by the District and connected to the District's mains, there shall be paid to the District the following public fire protection charge


	<u>Per Quarter or Per Year</u>	
Town of Andover	\$6,240	\$24,960

For each public fire hydrant owned and maintained by the District and installed after July 1, 2000, charges will be governed by Chapter 690 of the Commission's Rules and Regulation.

All public fire hydrants now existing or to be installed will be cared for and maintained in good working order (unavoidable accidents excepted) by the District. Once any fire hydrant is actually installed and in operation, the total annual fire protection service charge then in effect will not be reduced, even though the municipality served should order one or more of the hydrants moved to a different location. The municipality shall pay to the District all costs of removing and re-installing said hydrant or hydrants.
